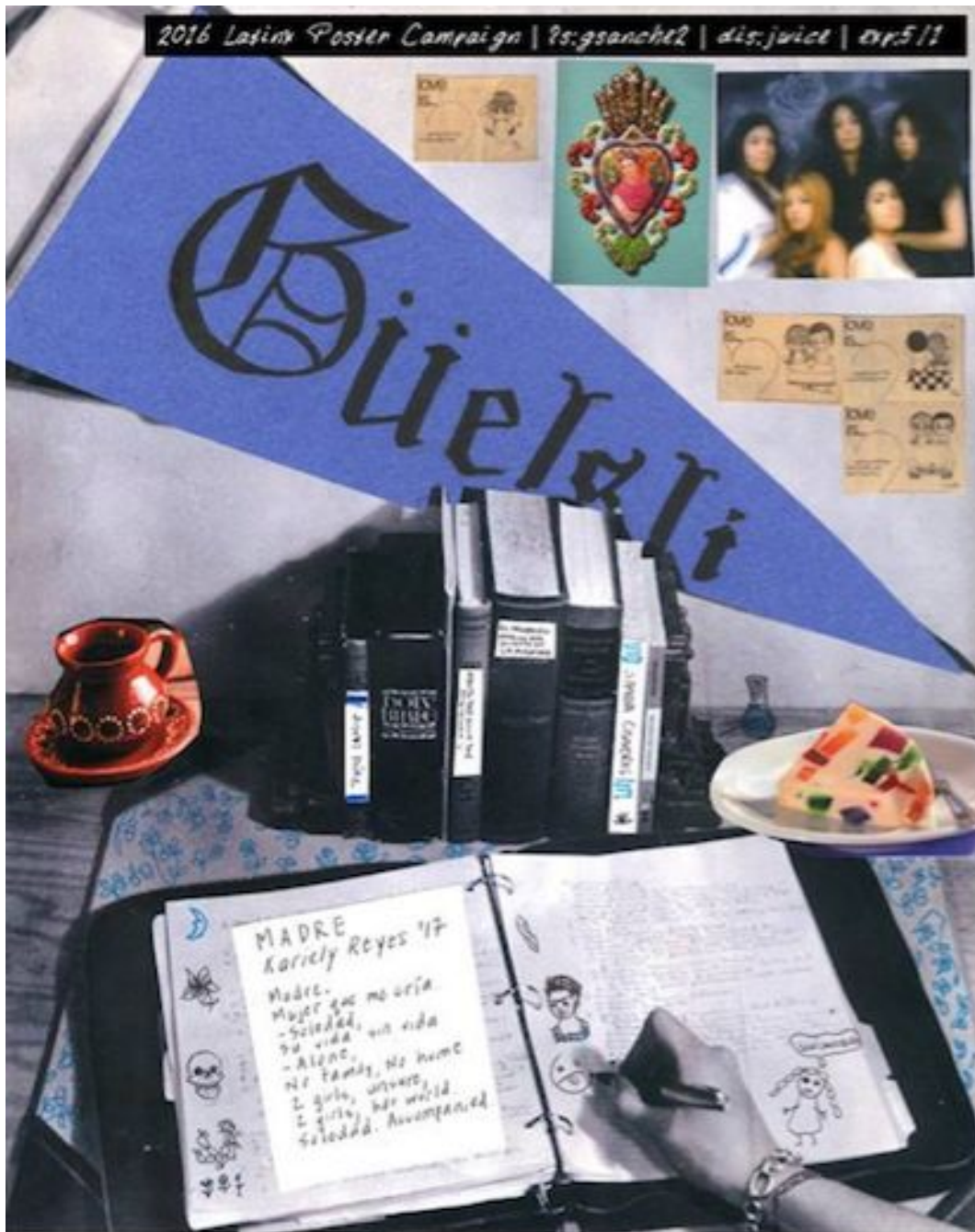

Such objectives are realized through various events sponsored by Mezcla throughout the year such as lectures, conferences, community service projects, and social gatherings.



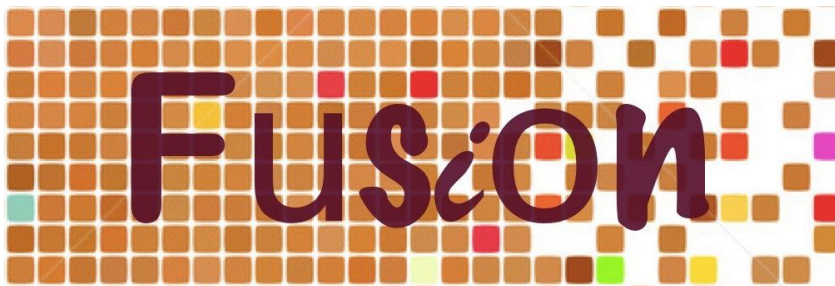
