

Faculty under review for reappointment, tenure, or promotion 2016-17



As specified in College legislation, the Committee on Faculty Appointments published last fall a list of faculty members to be reviewed in 2016-17 for tenure, promotion, reappointment, or merit increases. An updated list of the faculty members to be reviewed this spring, excluding candidates who requested that their names not be published, appears below.

All members of the college community are encouraged to write letters about faculty members being reviewed and send them to the Office of the Provost and Dean of the College, Attention: Jennifer Ellis (jellis5@wellesley.edu). Letters should be submitted before the R&P Committee's deadline to be most helpful. These letters are reviewed by the Committee on Faculty Appointments along with the student evaluation questionnaires. Many factors are considered in these decisions. These factors and the process of review, as well as the appropriate date for each review, are specified in *Articles of Government*, *Guidelines for Faculty on Term Appointments*, *Guidelines for Appointments of Instructors in Science Laboratory*, or *Guidelines for the Department of Physical Education, Recreation and Athletics*.

According to college policy, such letters are shared with the faculty member and his/her department chair, so any letter should indicate whether (1) the letter should be shared, as written, with your name left on it; or (2) the letter should be shared with your name and identifying wording removed. Letters may be submitted either in hard copy with a signature or electronically as an email or email attachment.

REAPPOINTMENTS of tenure-track faculty requiring a one-year notification. R&P Committee recommendations are due March 1, 2017. The candidates will be notified by the end of the academic year.

Reappointments depend on the availability of a position; some faculty members may not be reappointed simply because no position is available.
