
Event Metrics

Bank Account

- 2 signatories: Ideally club president and treasurer
- Bank letters available for non-profit status
- Reminder: WCAA files your club federal taxes

Dues = Paid Club Membership

- Go to club treasury
- Responsibility of club treasurer to track in AM and otherwise
- Can be tiered (i.e. GOLD dues etc.)

Club Gifts and Scholarship Funds

- Can be from dues and/or individual donations
- No additional Scholarship Funds can be created at this time
