

How to Find a Mental Health Provider

- Primary Care Provider : ask your PCP for a behavioral health referral during your next visit/check-up.
- Health Insurance Company : visit insurance website or call the customer service number on the back of your insurance card for support in finding an in-network provider. Visit <u>https://wellesley.thrivingcampus.com/help/</u> to learn the basics of using your insurance and finding a provider.
 - ONLY for International students with the Wellesley Student Insurance: students can search for providers outside of the U.S. by visiting <u>www.bcbsglobalcore.com</u> (type "XXP" in the search engine) or by calling 1-800-810-BLUE (2583) for a list of BlueCard, BlueCard PPO, and BlueCard Worldwide participating providers.
