# MAKING YOUR TRAVEL PLANS FOR ORIENTATION

#### ARRIVING AT WELLESLEY

Wellesley College welcomes domestic students and families to begin moving into the residence halls on Wednesday, August 31 starting at 8:00 am EST. Please keep in mind that there is a 4-hour window for moving in. You may avoid the early rush by arriving after 9:30 am. (International Student move-in will take place on Sunday, August 28, starting at 8:00 am EST. Details regarding the International Student Move-in checkin process can be found in international students' emails.)

#### IMPORTANT ARRIVAL TIPS

- Use the map and residence hall move-in guidelines sheet to minimize your waiting time and to help us manage the traffic flow.
- Watch for student leaders in Orientation t-shirts who will be available to greet you, and Public Safety Officers who will guide pedestrian and vehicular traffic, and answer any of your questions.
- Proceed directly to the designated dropoff area for your building, where you will unload the vehicle and bring your belongings up to your room.
- Plan to leave your car in the drop-off area for no more than 15 minutes. Someone should plan to remain with your car at all times and be ready to move it once the car is unloaded.
- After unloading, cars should be moved to one of the designated parking areas, as indicated on page 4 of this quide.
- Residence hall room keys, ID cards, and Orientation arrival packets will be distributed to students in each residence hall when you check in.
- Feel free to print this planning guide and bring it with you!

# TRANSPORTATION TO THE COLLEGE

#### **BY CAR**

Wellesley College is conveniently located close to the Massachusetts Turnpike and I-95/Route 128. For driving directions to the College, please visit www.wellesley.edu/about/visit/directionsmaps.

If you are using a GPS or an online mapping device, please use one of the following addresses below for your assigned residence hall area. Once you enter the campus, please proceed to your designated drop-off location.

Areas A, B, or C: 106 Central Street Wellesley, MA Areas D, E, and F\*: 727 Washington Street Wellesley, MA

#### BY BUS

Take the Greyhound or Peter Pan bus to the Riverside Terminal (one stop prior to Boston). From there take a taxi to Wellesley College.

#### **BY TRAIN**

Take Amtrak to South Station. From there, take the Commuter Rail (Framingham line) to Wellesley Square. From there take a taxi to Wellesley College.

#### **BY PLANE**

There are several ways to get to campus from Logan Airport in Boston:

• The Logan Express offers bus service between Logan Airport and Shoppers World, a shopping plaza located in nearby Framingham (\$22 round-trip charge per person). From Shoppers World, you may take a Wellesley College van directly to your residence hall. There is a \$10 charge per person for the College Van service and prior reservations are required. Please visit MyWellesley for more information and to complete the reservation form.

- Taxis are available at each terminal on the Arrivals Level (curbside). Uber or Lyft are also great options.
- Airport shuttles pick up passengers at Logan and drop off at several destinations.

- Another option is to take the Silver Line to South Station and follow the directions for arrival by train.

#### **MOVE-IN TIPS**

- Eat a good breakfast in the morning. This will be a long and busy day.
- Carrying those suitcases and boxes can be tiring. Bring a snack and a bottle of water with you.
- Pack smart—make all items light enough to carry easily as each hall has one elevator that will be busy on move-in day.
- To avoid having duplicate items that take up valuable room space, check with your roommate(s) prior to move-in day to talk about what you'll be bringing with you.
- Move-in day is exciting and special; remember to have your phone or a camera accessible so you can capture a memorable moment of your arrival at Wellesley College.
